DESCRIPTION

As part of CLT's ongoing terminal improvement program, the Arts & Science Council in partnership with the Public Art Commission and Charlotte Douglas International Airport will commission five Charlotte-based artists to create original artworks to be digitally reproduced on durable Custom Acrovyn panel and installed throughout the newly renovated Concourses of CLT Airport. **ASC is pleased to announce the names of the first round of selected artists (appearing in alphabetical order by last name) as follows: Ráed Al-Rawi, Nico Amortegui, Nellie Ashford, Jonathan Grauel and Ben Premeaux.** The Public Art Commission will shortlist a fresh selection of no fewer than 5 new artists drawn from the same pre-qualified pool for assigned art locations on Concourses C & D before the end of 2018 (exact date TBD).
